Dear Viking Nation Families,

With the most recent report for Tuscola County Covid-19 positive cases showing a very sharp increase at the end of today, Akron-Fairgrove is not immune to this and we are now beginning to experience staffing shortages. That being said, please be advised that effective tomorrow, Wednesday, November 11, 2020 there will be no face-to-face instruction for students Pre-K - 12th grade. Students will transition to remote learning on November 12, 2020 until November 30, 2020 and at that time we will reassess the Covid -19 status in Tuscola County and if there is a need to extend remote learning.

We do not make this decision lightly as we know the burden it places on families who need to work and we try to balance that with the health and welfare of our students and staff.

Chromebooks can be picked-up at your student's school building from 4:00pm-6:00pm tomorrow (Wednesday, November 11). Remote learning will begin on Thursday, November 12th and will follow the Google Classroom platform with which they are very familiar. Students should check for their class assignments beginning Thursday morning.

For those who are interested in picking up meals, you may do so on Tuesdays between 9:00am-10:00am at the Jr/Sr HS entrance. A text blast will go out to remind those wishing to take advantage of the meals.

Tech Center and athletic events will be optional for those involved in those activities.

This situation continues to change quickly and your understanding and cooperation in dealing with things beyond our control is greatly appreciated.
